The Parent/Guardian Honor Code is a set of guidelines designed to promote respect, integrity, and a positive environment for all students, parents/guardians, volunteers, and staff. By agreeing to this code, parents/guardians commit to supporting FrankTown's mission, encouraging good behavior, and modeling values that help children thrive. The staff at FrankTown also commits to do the same.

- I understand that for my student to participate, I must do my part before the deadline that has been communicated and that there will be no extensions.
- I understand that by signing my student up for an opportunity, it is my responsibility to communicate with FrankTown staff in advance any changes.
- It is my responsibility to make sure that FrankTown has my current contact information and I understand that initial information will be sent out via email.
- It is my responsibility to communicate with my student what I have signed them up for.
- I understand that if my student "no shows," the consequences could include being removed from the reward opportunities list; this includes things like field trips, the summer high school reward trip, summer camps, and Christmas/Back-to-School Shopping.
